



High School Personal Appearance Guidelines

STUDENT DRESS AND PERSONAL APPEARANCE

- Students are required to wear around their necks' student IDs/access cards at all times during school hours for their protection and security of the campus. Freshmen, sophomores, and juniors must wear the CCA lanyard provided by the school. Seniors are allowed to wear an appropriate lanyard of their choice.
- All uniform items must be purchased from Ivy School Uniforms with the exception of socks and shoes. Students are required to dress in accordance with one's biological sex.
- Polo and chapel shirts (with the exception of the girls' $\frac{3}{4}$ sleeve chapel shirt) must be tucked in throughout the day.
- All uniform items (including shoes) should be clean and in good repair.
- A black/brown leather belt must be worn with pants or shorts.
- No visible logos, insignias, or emblems other than CCA's should be on clothing. Socks may have logos that are white, gray, or black but may not have any other color on them or pattern (e.g. stripes). CCA uniform sweaters and embroidered CCA sweatshirts, and fleece CCA jackets may be worn over uniform shirts and blouses. Embroidered sweatshirts may not be worn on chapel days.
- Students must remain in uniform while on the CCA Campus during regular school hours. Athletic uniforms may be worn during official athletic practice or P.E. period only.
- Only plain, solid white, short sleeve undershirts may be worn under chapel shirts. White, gray or navy short sleeve undershirts may be worn under polo style shirts. Long sleeve undershirts may not be worn under short sleeve uniform shirts or blouses.
- Hats may not be worn inside the building unless part of a special dress day.
- Hemlines must be no shorter than 4" above the top of the knee for girls' skirts and shorts or boys' shorts.

GIRLS

In addition to the required and optional uniform items that are purchased from Ivy School Uniforms, girls will wear the following:

- Any solid black or navy flat dress shoe. Any black, white, and/or gray athletic shoes with non-marking soles. No colored logos, no colored laces, no patterns, or other embellishments.
 - If your student has need of alternate footwear due to injuries or issues, we require a new doctor's note every quarter (four times per school year) and the shoes must be solid black or white athletic shoes. We want the shoes to look as close to our uniform shoes as possible.
- Tights/Leggings – Girls may wear solid color white, navy, or black tights/leggings under skirts. If they choose to wear leggings, they must wear socks the same color as their leggings. Sweatpants are not considered to be tights/leggings and may not be worn under skirts or in the classroom at any time.
- Socks – On chapel day, girls must wear white knee socks or white crew socks. Non-chapel days, girls may wear black, navy or white crew/knee socks. Socks may have logos that are white, gray, or black but may not have any other color on them or pattern (e.g. stripes).
- Girls may wear up to 2 pairs of earrings. Body piercings or tattoos may not be visible while on campus or at any school related event.

- Skirts – Hemlines on skirts must be no shorter than 4" above the top of the knee. Modesty shorts must be worn under skirts. Please be mindful of this policy as your daughter grows throughout the school year. Christmas break is a great time to re-measure the skirts for length.
- Girls' hair should be kept neat, clean, and out of the face. Hair may not be streaked, dyed, or added to with any unnatural colors. Hairstyles should not distract other students or place undue attention on any one student, as determined by school administration.
- Any additional clothing accessories or cosmetics should not cause distractions.

BOYS

In addition to the required and optional uniform items that are purchased from Ivy School Uniforms, boys will wear the following:

- Any solid black dress shoes. Any black, white, and/or gray athletic shoes with non-marking soles. No colored logos, no colored laces, no patterns, or other embellishments.
 - If your student has need of alternate footwear due to injuries or issues, we require a new doctor's note every quarter (four times per school year) and the shoes must be solid black or white athletic shoes. We want the shoes to look as close to our uniform shoes as possible.
- Boys must wear black/white crew socks. Socks may have logos that are white, gray, or black but may not have any other color on them or pattern (e.g. stripes). No neon or bright colors.
- Boys' hair should be kept neat, clean, and out of the face. Hair may not be streaked, dyed, or added to with any unnatural colors. Hairstyles should not distract other students or place undue attention on any one student, as determined by school administration.
- Boys should be clean shaven
- Boys may wear 1 tasteful necklace as long as it does not distract from the uniform. They may not wear earrings. Body piercings or tattoos may not be visible while on campus or at any school related event.

CHAPEL UNIFORM

- All uniform items should be purchased at Ivy School Uniforms.
- Girls should wear the required plaid skirt, white Oxford shirt, white knee socks or white crew socks, and plain adjustable tie.
- The navy sweater vest is required in the late fall through early spring for 9th/10th grades.
- Boys should wear required grey slacks, white Oxford shirt, black socks, and the standard tie or bow tie. Ties must be in good repair and worn correctly.
- Juniors and seniors are required to wear the navy blazer for Chapel. This is provided through CCA or you may purchase your own to keep.
- Students in 11th/12th grade are allowed to wear the CCA light blue embroidered Oxford.
- No embroidered sweatshirts will be allowed on Chapel Day. CCA fleece zip-up jackets are allowed on Chapel Day.

PE UNIFORM GUIDELINES

- Athletic shoes must be worn during P.E. and athletics. Dress shoes or converse type sneakers are not allowed.
- Athletic attire should be modest and may not be modified to abbreviate coverage. Athletes are required to wear CCA attire while practicing. Only practice attire approved by CCA coaches and AD is permitted. T-shirts may not be ripped down the arm pit or the length changed in a revealing manner. A ribbed or tank-top style undershirt is unacceptable and may not be worn by athletes.
- Male athletes may not go "shirtless" during athletics when co-ed use of the facilities takes place.

- Female athletes should dress in a modest manner. The practice of rolling up shorts is not allowed. Female athletes may not wear tank tops or immodest clothing.
- All students must wear PE uniform purchased at the Cougar Gear Store or CCA approved team issued practice gear. Spirit wear may not be worn for PE or Athletics. All shorts must be no shorter than 4" above the top of the knee.

COLD WEATHER UNIFORM GUIDELINES

- Outerwear – Only official CCA jackets and embroidered sweaters purchased through Ivy School Uniforms may be worn. Outerwear must be in good condition - not ripped or torn in any way. Outerwear may not be worn during chapel assembly.
- Any non-CCA outwear may not be worn in the building.
- CCA hoodies may only be worn on spirit wear/house wear days.
- Long johns, warm-ups/sweatpants, pajama bottoms are not allowed.

SPIRIT WEAR DRESS GUIDELINES

- Authorized CCA spirit shirts, sweatshirts or hoodies are the only items allowed. If outerwear is worn on spirit wear days, the outerwear must be opened in the front.
- Shorts or skirts that are the standard uniform length may be worn.
- Solid color khaki, denim, black, navy, gray, royal, orange, or white joggers, pants, or jeans are allowed on spirit wear days.
- Distressed denim jeans/pants with no skin showing above the knees are permitted; no leggings, pajama pants or oversized sweatpants are allowed.
- Midriffs may not be exposed.
- Students may wear athletic shoes or other approved footwear, including cowboy boots. House shoes/slippers are not allowed.
- Students not wishing to participate or ineligible* to participate must wear a regular uniform option.
- Students not complying with these directives will be sent to the office and required to call home. They will lose the privilege of wearing spirit clothing and will need a regular uniform brought to them before they will be allowed in class.

SPECIAL DRESS GUIDELINES/FREE DRESS

Occasionally students have the opportunity to dress up for special events such as award banquets. Dress should be modest. No midriffs, spaghetti straps, halters, tank top, or strapless tops or dresses. Skirts must be the same length as uniform skirts. In the event that a theme day is allowed for Homecoming or other school spirit days, students' dress must be obvious in keeping with the theme (e.g. wearing pajamas on PJ Day is obviously keeping with the theme; wearing shorts and a t-shirt is not.) If a student chooses not to participate in theme days, they may wear spirit wear or their regular school uniform. Inappropriate writing or images on clothing will not be allowed. In the event that free dress is allowed, the spirit wear policy is the guideline for shorts, skirt, and pants choices.

**Students who receive 4 uniform infractions within a quarter are ineligible to participate in spirit wear/house wear days.*
